

## Coffee machines involvement with the Pressure Systems Safety Regulations 2000 (PSSR)

The Regulations are in place to reduce the associated risks and dangers to people from pressure systems situated in any workplace.

Coffee machines that incorporate a steam vessel are in scope of the Regulations. Steam systems have a special status.

The statutory provisions to identify certification:

- **Pressure Systems Safety Regulations 2000 (PSSR), Regulation 8(1):** which requires that a pressure system shall not be operated or used unless there is a certified written scheme for the periodic examination of the system by a competent person.
- **Pressure Systems Safety Regulations 2000 (PSSR), Regulation 9(1)(a):** which requires the system to be examined in accordance with that scheme.

Local Authorities require:

- ☐ Evidence or copy of a Certified Written Scheme of Examination (Reg 8)
- ☐ Evidence or copy of the latest Statutory Examination Report (Reg 9)
