## THE HEALTH AND SAFETY AT WORK ACT 1974 (HASWA)

It shall be the duty of every employer to ensure, so far as is reasonably practicable, the health, safety and welfare at work of all employees and that persons not in their employment are not thereby exposed to risks to their health or safety.

## HEALTH AND SAFETY EXECUTIVE (HSE) - PRESSURE SYSTEMS SAFETY REGULATIONS 2000 (PSSR) L122

The aim of PSSR is to prevent serious injury from the hazard of stored energy (pressure) as a result of the failure of a pressure system or one of its component parts.

### Regulation 8 Written scheme of examination\*

The user of an installed pressure system shall not operate the system or allow it to be operated unless they have a written scheme for the periodic examination in place, certified by a competent person.

### Regulation 9 Examination in accordance with the written scheme\*\*

The user of an installed pressure system must ensure that those parts of the pressure system included in the certified written scheme of examination are examined by a competent person within the intervals specified in the written scheme.

## SELECTING A COMPETENT PERSON

It is the responsibility of the user/owner to select a competent person capable of carrying out the duties in a proper manner with sufficient expertise in the particular type of system.
